Notes:

1. The 14th annual IFA Tournament, WorldNET10 will take place at The University of Leeds' Bodington Hall on the 23/24/25 July 2010.
2. To enter, a team must be a bona fide IFA team, an official entry form must be completed and submitted with the correct entry fee. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis.
3. The main tournament will have a maximum entry of 64 teams. The Veterans tournament will have a maximum entry of 16 teams. Depending on interest in the tournament these numbers may be reduced at any date after 1st December 2009.
4. Each team entered must have at least one member on the WorldNET2002 Yahoo Group at all times.
5. The event will open on the evening of Friday 23rd July with the Scotland vs England Internationale followed by the IFA Challenge Cup Final.
6. Saturday 24th July will see group games played for the main competition and the Vets Competition.
7. Sunday 25th July will see a knock-out contest for the Cup, Plate and Vets Bowl.
8. The entry fee before 5pm on Tuesday December the 1st 2009 will be £300 and £350 thereafter and must be paid in full at the time of submitting an entry. Entry fees are not refundable.
9. A copy of the official entry form, details of how to submit entries and the competition rules will be available on the worldnet.org.uk website.
10. A list of competent entries for each tournament will appear on the worldnet.org.uk website.
11. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry which does not meet the competition rules.
12. Teams who do not abide by the IFA rules regarding officials will face immediate expulsion from the tournament and all future IFA activities.

The relevant sentence from the rules is:

"Physical and persistent verbal abuse of officials by players or members of a team's organisation will not be tolerated under any circumstances, and will result in the offending team's instant expulsion from the tournament."

We will expect all participating teams to uphold this fundamental tenet of the tournament.
